Baggage Requirements & Fees

Information for Students and Parents

The majority of air carriers now charge for checked luggage when taking an airline flight. This information is provided to help you understand the facts about these charges and when they apply.

Carry On Luggage

Passengers may carry onto the aircraft without charge:
One Bag plus One Personal item



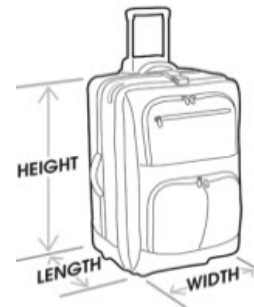
Carry-On Luggage Limitation:
 22" long, 14" wide, 9" high
 Combined cannot exceed 45"

Must fit in Airport Luggage Sizer
 Weighs no more than 40lbs
 (when combined with other carry-on item)

Carry-On Personal Item:
 Backpack, Purse, Briefcase, Laptop or similar items such as
 book bags or totes.
 Cannot exceed 36" and must fit under seat

Checked Luggage

All checked luggage is subject to charge:
Luggage is subject to Size and Weight Limitations



Checked Luggage Limitation:
 Combined dimensions cannot exceed 62"
 Weighs no more than 50lbs

Checked Baggage Fees: * (per direction)

1st Checked Bag	\$25.00
2nd Checked Bag	\$35.00
3rd & Over (each bag)	\$100.00

Over-Weight Baggage Fees: * (per direction)

50lbs to	70lbs	\$50.00
70lbs to	100lbs	\$100.00
exceeds	100lbs	Cargo

Q. Can Checked Baggage fees be paid in advance?

A. No. Airlines currently do not provide any way for customers or travel agencies to pay in advance for baggage fees.

Q. With the amount I've already paid, I cannot afford anything more for baggage fees. What can I do?

A. We recommend all students pack in carry-on luggage to avoid fees. With careful packing (and taking only what you will need), just about everyone can survive a three or four day trip with only carry-on luggage.

Q. What about my student's band instrument?

A. The band director and/or group leader will provide instructions about how band equipment will be handled.
